

EU Pet Passport Audit Checklist

Barks and Life Sparks

A printable pre-travel check for the little blue booklet: identity, microchip, rabies page, vet stamps, and journey fit.

How to use this checklist

Tick each box after you check the original passport. If anything is unclear, missing, expired, or does not match your journey, ask your vet before travelling.

1. Owner Details

- Owner name is correct
- Owner address is present and current
- Owner signature is present where required
- Details match the person travelling or responsible for the pet

2. Pet Identity

- Pet name, species, breed, sex, colour, and date of birth checked
- Microchip number matches vet record or scanner result
- Microchip date or read date is clear
- Microchip details match the rabies vaccination entry

3. Rabies Page

- Rabies vaccination is recorded
- Vaccine date is clear
- Valid from and valid until dates are clear
- Vaccine name, manufacturer, or batch details are present
- Vet stamp and signature are clear

4. Tapeworm Treatment

- Tapeworm treatment is needed for this route: Yes / No / Check
- Date and time are recorded
- Product name is present
- Vet stamp and signature are clear

5. Journey Check

- Passport is valid for my residency situation
- Passport is valid for this journey
- Animal Health Certificate needed instead: Yes / No / Check
- Original document packed, not only photos or copies

6. Final Document Check

- Issuing vet details are present and readable
- No obvious missing pages, damaged pages, or unclear entries
- Phone photos saved as backup
- Vet contact details saved before travel
